## **Early Childhood Trauma Training**

## **Supporting Young Children Who Have Experienced Sexual Abuse**

Young child sexual abuse is far more common than recognized, yet systems remain underprepared to respond. Misconceptions about early memory, disbelief that young children can be abused, lack of knowledge and skills interviewing children under five, and limited cross-system collaboration all create barriers. This presentation inspires professionals to act within their roles, partner across systems, and "speak the unspeakable" to better protect young children.
